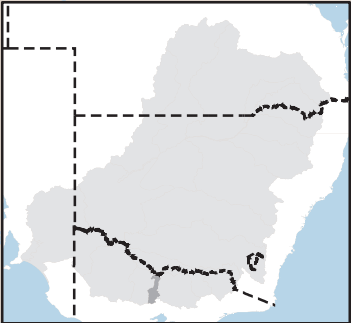


# CAMPASPE REGION - Key Environmental Assets and Hydrologic Indicator Sites
